## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

WHO: Project Applicant, Jamie Kutch and Kristen Green, Permit Sonoma File No. PLP22-0003

WHAT: Request for a Use Permit and Design Review for a new winery (Kutch Winery). Phase 1 of the proposed development includes a new winery building used for production, storage, and other related uses necessary to produce a maximum annual production of 500 gallons of distilled spirits from fruit grown on site, and a maximum annual production of 12,000 cases of wine, with 100% of grapes being sourced locally from the estate and other local vineyards within Sonoma County. Phase 2 of the proposed development includes construction of a new tasting room, with a patio, storage, office space. No agricultural promotional events or industry-wide events, or amplified noise are proposed. The project will be entirely located on the 12.15 +/- acre property located at 190 Wilson Rd Sebastopol, APN 077-140-018. Supervisorial District 5.

**Parcel Zoning**: Diverse Agriculture (allowed density: 20 acres per dwelling unit) with a combining district for Scenic Resources.

In accordance with Public Resource Code and CEQA Guidelines, the County of Sonoma provides notice to agencies and interested parties that it is releasing a final Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the project. The IS/MND did not find potential environmental impacts that could not be mitigated to a less-than-significant level.
