

Sonoma County Local Coastal Plan Update Map Revisions

Summary:

The following mapping revisions were approved by the Board of Supervisors at the April 4, 2023, and July 17, 2023, public hearings. The following revisions, adopted by the Board of Supervisors are not visually reflected in the attached DRAFT map series. Mapping Corrections:

Figure C-LU-1 Land Use Map Series: SubArea 8 Pacific View/Willow Creek:

On April 4, 2023, the Board of Supervisors took a straw vote to approve the Staff Recommendation for technical correction to APNs 097-210-004 and 097-210-005 to correct the land use designation as identified in the discussion papers for the April 4, 2023 hearing. Prior to certification Figure C-LU-1h will be revised to designate APNs 097-210-004 and 097-210-005 as Resources and Rural Development, consistent with the current zoning and land use designation in the 2001 Local Coastal Plan as adopted at the July 17 2023 Board of Supervisors hearing.

Figures C-OSRC-2a through -2k Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Map Series:

On July 17, 2023, the Board of Supervisors adopted revisions to Figures C-OSRC-2a through -2k formerly titled the Environmentally Sensitive Habitat map series. The Board action included that Figures C-OSRC-2a through -2k be renamed to "Study Area Maps" and that the mapped Sanctuary Preservation and Conservation Areas (as shown on the Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Map series dated 10/20/2020) be remapped to the limits of those areas as shown 2001 Local Coastal Plan Open Space and Resource Conservation map boundaries. The Board also requested that the expanded areas shown as Sanctuary Conservation Areas in the 10/20/2020 map series, but not previously certified as Sanctuary Preservation or Conservation Areas, be formally identified on the legend as "Study Areas". The Board noted the map series should reflect that the figures are not an inventory of Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Areas consistent with the adopted text of Open Space and Resource Conservation Section 8.

<u>Figures C-PA-1a through -1k Public Access Plan Map Series:</u>

On July 17, 2023, the Board of Supervisors approved the Planning Commission's recommended Public Access Map Series. The Board also approved the Errata Memo and an updated Appendix B, Public Access Plan as part of the Staff Recommendation for Technical Corrections, which contained corrections to the status of Access Points/Trailheads based on the current status provided by Regional Parks. The Planning Commission recommended Public Access Map Series was recommended for approval by the Planning Commissions in 2022 did not reflect the Technical Corrections, or Errata Corrections as provided by Sonoma County Regional Parks for the July 17, 2023 hearing.






FIGURE C-OSRC-2d Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Areas (ESHA) SubArea 4 Salt Point


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
